Expect your stay within the Lake Cascade Recreation Area to be fun, thrilling, challenging and exhausting.

There is a bundle of riding variety including boondocking, high marking, ridge running, and trail riding. What will seem like endless acres of high elevation snowpack will wear you out trying to track it up.

Load up the sleds on your trailer and drive over the Big Creek Summit into Warm Lake Basin for some unique riding. The Tyndall Ridge country often produces the "first, deepest and driest" snow in Idaho. From this vantage point you can look (not ride) right into the heart of the Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness and the view is nothing short of spectacular. Stop by North Shore Lodge and warm up with a bowl of chili on your way back to Cascade.

The reaction most first time visitors have is "no crowds". Accommodations include hotel/motel and vacation rentals. There are plenty of places to eat and all at a reasonable working man's price.

This is a family friendly place and it is real easy to make a week-long stay of your trip.

If you are not too pooped for some evening entertainment, treat yourself to a movie at the authentically restored "ROXY THEATER" or take a trip out to the Gold Fork Hot Springs and soak those weary bones. You might have time to catch the elk feeding hayride at the Points Ranch as well.



Overnight your sled at most motels and ride right from your room. No trailering! It is just a short skip and a jump to the westside groomed trail system. No kidding, you can be at 7500' elevation in rump deep powder within 15 minutes of your motel room.



Fuel is readily available at one of 4 fuel stops including non-ethanol premium. Av-gas (100 octane) available at the Airport as well. It is possible to ride your Sled to the gas pumps. Sleds are legal on city streets.
