

## Chamber of Commerce Minutes: 9-12-17

Number of people in attendance: Eight

Meeting was called to order at 12:14 pm

- Previous weeks minutes were distributed. Kathy Hull moved to accept the minutes with the correction of the Hog Wild date made. Alyssa Moreno moved to second the motion, all were in favor.
