### Minutes

### Events Comm.

They are meeting at noon at Umpqua Wednesday the 10 to talk about Memorial Day and 4<sup>th</sup> of July. There is an idea of having a directory of things to do, events to hand out at the 4<sup>th</sup> parade. We also want to make the 4<sup>th</sup> theme specific to Cascade.

The plan for Memorial Day weekend is to have a softball tournament, disc golf tournament, and rummage sale. Don't want to overlap too much with Donnelly sales on Saturday. We need to get this information out to all newspapers in the area and on the radio. Ask the city to block off Pine Street for vendors.

Friends of Lake Cascade are working to improve the water quality of the lake. They are doing a lot of research and testing of the water and making headway on restrictions to cattle, new fencing, septic leech field investigations, etc. They are afraid that it will affect not only the tourists that come to the lake, but also the health of people, animals, livestock, etc.

### Kristal-CAP

They have a lot to offer the youth in the area. The CAP has 12 people on their advisory board. They have an average of 12 kids for the program each day. Cascade received \$109,000 for the program. That is paying for her director position, an assistance coordinator, and 2 tutors. Kristal would like feedback from the community on the program and what parents want their kids to get out of the program and what they want them to do and learn. They want to improve the program and keep the kids coming back each year. Her goal is to have 40 kids next year. The Grant is written for 40 kids, and after 4 years, they need to be self sustaining. In June, they will be offering a 2 week day camp to the kids for free. They want to incorporate swimming lessons and hiking.

The new library coordinator is Amelia Valisek.

There will be a job fair at the school on May 1<sup>st</sup>.

The Geothermal working group is getting back together. They helped the school get geothermal heating and also the rec center start theirs. They will have a meeting at City Hall at 5pm on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup>.

Jackie from the WCM Leadership Academy is looking for feedback on their annual project. They want to build bike racks in each community, NM, Donnelly, McCall, Cascade. Where should they be put, what should they look like, etc.

Theresa Perry said the Grand Opening of the new State Parks building will be May 21<sup>st</sup> at 5pm.

Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> from 2-4 at the Legion they will need help stuffing eggs for the easter egg hunt on the 20<sup>th</sup> at Armstrong Park.

There will be a mini bull competition on June 29<sup>th</sup> at the Fairgrounds, the same day as the WCM Arts Festival down at Fischer Pond.
