Welcome to Cascade billboard rendering will be here in early December. Peppershock is working on this. The second phase of project (Part B) will address the section below the billboard for local event advertising. Part B signage cost could be covered by the local organizations and used as ITC grant match funds.

Julie will research the ownership of the reader board in front of the old Wellington's Realty office.

The existing Cascade tourist map needs updating. The Chamber will work with marketing committee on this project and explore funding options for the 2020-2021 ITC grant year.

Chamber Board Nominations are closed. The existing board officers were nominated with no additional write ins. The Member at large: Michelle Thibodeux, student at Cascade School, and Patty Wold, Cascade Schools. Scotty motions to approve. Jack seconds. All in favor.

The Chamber will partner with West Mtn snowmobile Club for the February 15th event. Ride funds will go to the snowmobile club, the Chamber will handle the dinner. The dinner will be spaghetti and fettuccine. The cost is \$11 but we will charge \$13 per person for it. Initial count is 150. There will also be Nordic skiing at Hasbrouck Ranch, and Tackle Tom's Cascade Cup fishing derby the same weekend. Poster will cost \$37.18 for 50 count. Brian will go back to Bobbi to set up cost from Peppershock.

Renting the Legion will be \$285 plus \$100 cleaning fee. The Legion might reimburse some of the rental fee. Proceeds from the event will be used for the fireworks in 2020 as well as a scholarship for a Cascade local. We will not be raffling a snowmobile this year, potentially a four wheeler or stand up paddleboard.

The Legion is having a Turkey Dinner from 1-3pm.

On 12/7 there will be auditions for the Valley Home Companion Show.

Tom from CMC has the strategic plan draft complete. They would like to share this plan with other organizations throughout town. They need 30 minutes to present it. Tom will present this on January 21st to the Chamber.
