## Hasbrouck Ranch

From Hwy 55 at Clear Creek, go 1.2 miles west on Cabarton Road to the parking area on the south side of the road.

There are about 5 miles of trails among rolling meadows and aspen groves. Winter wildlife abounds along these trails. The westerly and more difficult trail offers views of Long Valley and the East Mountains.

Dogs allowed only on Rover's Roundabout. Please keep your dog under control at all times. Please clean up after your dog. No trash or dog waste in porta potty.

## Crown Point Trail

From Hwy 55 north of Cascade, turn left on Vista Point Boulevard, at stop sign drive straight ahead to parking area. Campground is to your left.

Crown Point Trail is an old railroad bed that parallels the shore of Lake Cascade. It is an easy flat trail with spectacular vistas. A short section of trail is also maintained within the Crown Point campground. This trail is in a multi-use corridor. You may encounter snowmobiles.
