Don Weber- Cascade Waterfall

Don made a presentation to chamber members stating he has taken the project lead on getting the "Cascade Waterfall" located on City property at the north end of town across from Waters Edge RV Resort up and running. Don is seeking chamber support. Don expressed the waterfall has not been operable for the past four years due to the need for pump replacement. Don has been in direct contact with Ashley Thompson of Ashley Inn and reported Ashley has purchased a new pump for \$9,000.00. Ashley agreed to cover the cost of the pump but can no longer cover power/water costs. Don provided project overview/needs (1) waterfall needs new liner, (2) volunteer labor force needed for rock removal, pump replacement, rock reinstallation, etc., (3) donation jars will be placed around town to collect funds to cover power and water cost for waterfall project, (4) need to find an ongoing funding source to cover power and water cost to operate the waterfall 3-5 months per year (perhaps funding can be secured through Idaho Power's community grant program).
